ROARIN MISSILE was urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the outset, dueled for command on the turn, shook clear nearing midstretch and held EVACUATION ROUTE safe to the end under firm encouragement. The latter was reserved from striking distance while being guided to the inside in the opening stages, saved ground on the turn gathering momentum, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and found his best stride late to close the gap on the winner. PETERS ROCK joined the pace outside a rival from the outset, pressed the pace to upper stretch and weakened in late stages while lasting for a share. BARRACUDA BAY raced unhurried dropping off the leaders in the opening stages, shifted out entering upper stretch and continued evenly. ALL TANKED UP tracked off the first flight from just out of striking distance racing into the turn and emptied out after a half. POINTING NORTH (SAF) was outpaced early, trailed the field to the stretch and was vanned off after the race.
