Footnotes

MORIOBA gained a forward placing stalking just off the pacesetter under light rating racing to the backstretch, steadily moved to terms with that foe on the second bend, edged forward into the lane, then was roused left handed through the stretch to maintain a clear advantage. MISSION STORM angled inwards racing under rating while taking up a position between foes in the second flight, shifted out three deep racing into the stretch while being roused to challenge the winner but couldn't gain terms with that foe. APPELLA'S WONDER was rated off the second flight along the rail racing to the backstretch, continued along the inside on the second bend, angled out four wide racing through the stretch and continued with a mild bid to earn a share. BACARELLA angled inside early to track the leaders as part of the second flight, switched a bit off the inside to bid between foes racing through the stretch but finished evenly late. COAMING was settled along the inside racing to the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch, then shifted off the inside while making an effort to improve position. D FIFTY, reserved three deep tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn, never gained contention. JUKEBOX GEM moved to the fore from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the rail to the second bend and gave way nearing midstretch when failing to match the winner. GIVENCHI ducked out at the start, settled three deep racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. LUCIA BUNS, held up between foes in early stages, offered no closing response. ABBY'S SLEW was a brief factor racing three deep in the second flight tracking just off the leaders to the second bend but emptied out nearing upper stretch. BACK LIKE A SONG was settled last early and never threatened.
