Footnotes

BEYOND was rated outside foes tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening half, made steady progress advancing on the leaders four wide racing through the far turn, continued in that path into upper stretch and wore down the pacesetter to prevail in time under firm right handed encouragement. BIN ELUSIVE shifted off the inside while maintaining striking distance stalking the leaders racing to the backstretch, moved to terms with those foes three deep on the second bend, was roused to wrest command in upper stretch while shifting momentarily into the path of REAL GOOD TIME and resisted the winner's bid to late stages while just failing to contain that foe. BONNIE ROSE, reserved near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out to race between foes through the backstretch into the second bend, shifted out of close quarters nearing midstretch and continued with a mild bid while prevailing for a share. REAL GOOD TIME was urged to gain a forward placing prompting the pacesetter racing into the backstretch, pressed the issue between foes through the far turn, was carried inwards a bit in upper stretch and gave way. MISS MY ROSIE, held up along the inside tracking the leaders in second flight, was urged to lodge a brief bid between foes entering upper stretch but had no final kick. FRONTIER DAYS sprinted to the lead while angling to the rail, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the far turn and emptied out abruptly in upper stretch.
