Footnotes

COMMANDO KAT broke slowly, made steady progress while angling inside to gain contention midway through the turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, then shifted off the rail in the closing stages to split foes three deep and wrested command under strong handling. PROUD JACKSON settled outside foes in the opening stages, made steady progress five wide racing into the stretch to strike the front between calls but couldn't contain the winner. CLOUT settled along the inside for a half, then made steady progress between foes near the inside in late stages to close the gap. MOSQUILLO tracked just off the first flight under rating racing to the bend, moved to challenge four wide nearing upper stretch while gaining a brief advantage but quickly flattened out. STRONGEST LINK tracked the leaders four wide between foes, was fanned nearing upper stretch but quickly emptied out. AUGUST DAY

joined the pace four wide in the opening stages, pressed the issue racing into the turn and gave way leaving midstretch. FORT DEFIANCE tracked the leaders between foes from out of striking distance early and never gained contention. SHERIFF MAX never seriously menaced. GAMBLIN JACK shifted outside foes early, raced six wide into the turn while being prompted to advance but never seriously menaced. MOST DISTINCT dueled for command along the inside racing into the bend and gave way early. DOUBLE SILVER vied for command three wide between foes in the opening stages but emptied out after a half. TRUST MORE was urged to dispute the pace between foes racing to the turn and gave way after a half.
