Footnotes

GINNY'S CLASSIC was urged to the fore while shifting to the inside in the opening quarter, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the second bend and steadily widened her advantage to the end under pressure. BEACH CLUB, urged to gain a position inside foes in the second flight, shifted out nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance, couldn't menace the winner but continued with a sustained effort to prevail for place honors. CALL ME CLASSY

tracked off the second flight along the inside, steadily improved her position along the rail racing into the stretch but was outfinished for second. CHAMPAGNE SPIRIT tracked off the second flight between foes racing to the turn, angled out in upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. ART OF DECEPTION settled between foes three deep racing to the turn, shifted outside foes racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. HEMET TAP settled between foes in the last flight racing into the turn, then passed between some tiring rivals racing through the stretch while making no impression. ANYONESHOME, reserved in last while being guided to the rail, saved ground on the bend but never gained contention. EYEMA DELIGHT tracked the pace between foes off the second flight racing into the bend but lacked a closing response. FLY UNITEDLY settled outside foes early, was caught four wide throughout and proved no factor. SLIGO ROSE was a brief factor three deep tracking off the second flight in the opening half but retreated from contention early. QUEEN FOR LIFE settled outside foes, was fanned five wide racing into the stretch and proved no threat. SWEET HARP chased the pacesetter outside a rival racing into the turn and gave way abruptly after five furlongs.
