Footnotes

I GOT RHYTHM broke outwards bumping RENO STAR, was quickly righted to gain the advantage between calls racing nearest the rail in the opening furlong, was headed nearing the half mile marker but continued with a steady effort to press the issue racing into upper stretch, then drew clear in the closing stages under firm hand urging. BONNIE settled off the second flight while angling to the inside, saved ground to upper stretch, then found her best stride late while continuing along the rail to narrowly prevail for second on the wire. RENO STAR, bumped at the start, recovered to gain a position just off the first flight, made an early move to challenge for command between foes near the half mile marker, dueled for command outside a rival to upper stretch and steadily weakened in late stages before losing second on the wire. BEDROOM EYES broke awkwardly losing position to the field, recovered to gain a position between foes in the second flight near the inside racing into the bend, shifted three wide entering upper stretch and continued with an even effort while being narrowly outfinished for a share. DEVOUT DIVA was a brief factor prompting the pace three deep racing into the turn and gave way after a half. MONTANA DREAM was a brief factor four deep in the opening stages but dropped out of contention early. SAVE YOUR STORY tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn but lacked the needed closing response.
