Footnotes

TWELVE HUNDRED gained terms with a rival on the lead attending that foe's pace in the opening stages, was urged to press the issue racing into upper stretch, took over leaving the furlong marker and held UNCLE JEEP safe under steady handling. The latter was urged to gain a position inside a rival in the second flight racing just out of striking distance in the opening stages, steadily drew into contention while shifting out three wide in upper stretch and continued willingly to close the gap to the end. RIVERSHIRE, held up off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, made steady progress splitting foes on the turn to gain position nearing upper stretch, then shifted out in late stages while continuing with a steady effort to prevail for a share. J. PA tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn, made a brief bid in tandem with that foe nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. BLUE CANOE settled outside foes in the last flight early, then came around foes to gain some position racing four wide on the turn to upper stretch. MISH MOSH sped to the fore while shifting to the inside, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn and gave way leaving the furlong marker when failing to match the winner. DEMIGOD tracked off the second flight outside rivals racing to the turn and never gained contention. DUSTINCASE briefly tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing to the turn but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. NUCKSER bobbled at the start, settled in the last flight and never gained contention. BIG REWARD tracked the leaders three deep in second flight racing into the turn but retreated from contention early.
