UPPERLINE secured a forward placing along the rail while racing on terms with the pacesetter in the opening stages, was eased off that foe to stalk the leaders along the inside nearing the backstretch, continued in that fashion while awaiting an opening racing through the far turn, shifted out nearing the furlong marker and responded readily to wrest command and draw clear under firm right handed encouragement. HOOH WHY broke outwards bumping ARIANA D, was quickly righted to join the pace between foes racing into the first turn, pulled her way to a narrow advantage nearing the backstretch, dictated the pace under rating on a narrow margin to the second bend, was roused clear racing into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner in the last furlong. ARIANA D, bumped at the start, settled off the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes to advance three deep racing into the far turn, drew into striking distance after six furlongs but lacked the needed final kick. HEMERA, reserved saving ground behind the second flight in the opening half, continued along the rail throughout and made an effort to improve her position inside foes racing into the stretch. LA GRAN BAILADORA was settled in last racing a bit off the inside in the opening half, swung five wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. SEA LEVEL DRIVE, forwardly placed three deep in the opening stages, prompted the pacesetter racing into the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. KATHMANBLU, held up just off the first flight between foes racing to the backstretch, continued outside a rival in second flight for five furlongs but came up empty racing into the far turn.
