Footnotes

WITH A TWIST, reserved in last along the inside racing to the backstretch, switched outside foes nearing the far turn, circled the field four wide racing into upper stretch to gain the advantage racing past the furlong marker and held COMPELLING CASE to the end under firm encouragement. The latter was settled just outside the eventual winner in the last flight in the opening stages, continued unhurried just off the inside racing into the second bend, split foes just off the inside racing into upper stretch, then switched outside the leader through the closing stages while continuing willingly to the end to close the gap. HOIST THE COLORS stalked the pacesetter between foes leading the second flight on a narrow margin under rating in the opening half, moved to press the issue on the far turn, gained a brief advantage between calls racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain that momentum. BELLA SERENADE tracked the leaders three deep between foes in the opening stages, then continued evenly in that path into the stretch while failing to menace the top pair. OSKEE WOW WOW, forwardly placed four deep racing to the backstretch, emptied out racing into upper stretch. SUMMER AGAIN was rank in traffic, then steadied along the inside racing into the first turn, dropped into last on the backstretch and never gained contention. INDIAN ARTIFACT moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace to the far turn and emptied out nearing midstretch. MILESTONEMISSILE was guided to the rail early tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight but steadily retreated after a half.
