CHEQUE APPEAL tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance while off the inside, made a steady advance three deep to challenge entering upper stretch, closed the gap on the pacesetter in tandem with TAR HEEL THRILL while being floated out a bit by that foe in the last furlong but prevailed on the wire under brisk right handed pressure. The latter, settled off the pace in the opening quarter, advanced to striking distance off the inside racing into upper stretch, drifted out under left handed pressure in the last furlong engaging the winner for command and was narrowly outfinished. BANK ACCOUNT angled inwards to attend a rival's pace racing into the bend, pressed the issue on the turn, edged forward to a clear advantage in upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the final furlong. WHODO, outpaced in early stages, never gained contention. JAKE'S SOLDIER tracked just off the leaders racing four wide early and came up empty after a half. JOHNNIES BREEZE angled to the inside in the opening furlong while disputing the lead, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way after a half.
