Footnotes

DOROTHY Y gained a forward placing outside a rival in the opening stages, attended that foe's tempo racing to the bend, moved to wrest command after a half and was roused clear racing through the stretch to prove clearly best. TOP PAIR shied inwards at the start avoiding LE BEE, was settled into stride along the rail racing to the turn, shifted out four wide splitting foes leaving the quarter mile marker, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. BUZZ MY BELL worked her way to the inside tracking the leaders in second flight in the opening quarter, shifted off the inside while being urged to striking distance midway through the turn brushing JUDY MY DARLING, angled outside that foe entering upper stretch and continued well enough to edge a rival for a share. JUDY MY DARLING, held up off the first flight in the opening stages, tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight racing into the turn, was carried out a bit midway through the bend, was urged to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch and flattened out in late stages. SHARE THE JOY, bumped at the start, was settled outside foes racing behind the second flight, continued four deep on the turn and never gained contention. DAKOTA SONG broke outwards bumping SHARE THE JOY, was quickly righted to set the pace along the inside racing into the turn but gave way after a half. LE BEE swerved inwards at the start, was righted to track behind the second flight off the inside, continued three deep between foes into the bend, steadied out of close quarters leaving the five sixteenths marker and had no further response.
