Footnotes

IOYA BIGTIME, brushed by HOODLUM at the start, was reserved in hand while angling inwards racing into the first turn while well out of striking distance, shifted out three deep entering the backstretch, commenced a steady advance in that path nearing the far turn, was carried out a bit nearing upper stretch but continued with a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm left handed encouragement. KING ROOTIN TOOTIN, held up off the second flight in the opening half, split foes entering the far turn while being urged to press outside the pacesetter, lost some position to that foe entering upper stretch but continued with interest to edge that foe for second on the wire. DEVILS TOWER was urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing into the backstretch, edged forward to a narrow advantage nearing the far turn, set the pace into upper stretch while being roused clear but faltered in the final sixteenth. DANCE FOR PACO, bumped by L. B. EXPRESS at the start, settled well off the second flight early, advanced to contention inside foes entering the far turn in tandem with the eventual winner, shifted out near the quarter mile marker brushing IOYA BIG TIME and couldn't match that rival's final kick. HOODLUM, bumped at the start by LIMESTONE and forced into his entrymate, was settled outside foes in the opening stages, continued with interest while caught four wide racing through the far turn and improved his position to the end. E. BLUE worked his way to the inside early racing well out of striking distance and continued evenly to late stages. PROUD NATION tracked just off the first flight along the inside racing to the far turn but emptied out in late stages. LIMESTONE broke outwards bumping HOODLUM, was settled between foes racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. L. B. EXPRESS broke awkwardly bumping DANCE FOR PACO, settled off rivals and never menaced thereafter. MASTMAN, a bit reluctant to load, went up to prompt the pace

outside a rival racing to the far turn and gave way. SAILING ALONG was a brief factor outside foes three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch but gave way abruptly entering the far turn.
