Footnotes

PROMULGATION was unhurried early, angled out widest in the turn, then ran the down leader while urged. BILL'S PRESENCE was never far back, had a brief lead, but was not good enough. CLASSIC CHANT raced on the rail early, lacked room in the turn but couldn't get the winner. HEAVENS TOUR had a wide trip, raced close up early and did not rally. DROPLET went evenly and not a threat. OPERETTA ITALIANO was of void early speed, passed tired ones and was widest in the stretch. WALLINGFORD was wide in the turns, made a middle move and came up empty. LANCELOT'S LOVE set the early pace inside and faded in the lane.
