Footnotes

TESSIES TILBURY vied for command along the inside from the outset, edged forward to a slight advantage approaching the wire and just held the challenge of SHAQUITA under firm handling. The latter, shuffled a bit along the rail just after the start, shifted off the inside gaining some position, split foes while angling back to the rail late and just missed. STIVERS SUPRISE tracked just off the leaders three deep racing to the bend, was fanned four wide racing through the stretch and continued willingly for a share while outkicked by the top pair. PRINCESS FREEBIE angled inwards sharply to prompt the pace outside a rival, dueled for command past midstretch but weakened late. GILDED TREASURE, reserved off the inside in early stages, split foes racing into upper stretch to briefly menace but had no final kick. SAGEDUST tracked just outside the first flight in early stages, made a brief, three wide bid on the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. PUSH BUTTON, carried inwards at the start by WILL'S RUN, never gained contention. WILL'S RUN shied inwards at the start, tracked just off the leaders along the inside to the bend, then steadily faded from contention.
