GRAZIE, carried out a bit just after the start, moved to a position outside a rival in second flight racing into the first turn, made steady progress to gain striking distance entering the far turn, bid three wide for command nearing upper stretch, drifted inwards when edging forward nearing midstretch, bobbled a bit racing over some tire tracks in the final sixteenth but held sway to the end under strong handling while fully extended. YUKAN B CLASSY TOO, caught a bit wide in the opening stages, angled inwards while settling off the pace, shifted outside foes entering the far turn while making steady progress to gain striking distance, angled four wide in upper stretch to challenge, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. IOYA BIGTIME broke awkwardly, was settled into stride, split foes advancing to contention through the far turn and made mild progress to the end. BRISTOL BOY was settled along the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside foes on the far turn to race five deep into upper stretch but improved his position to the end. POOF AND GONE, forced out a bit in traffic just after the start, tracked the pace outside foes just off the second flight racing to the far turn but had no closing response. SHANE'S SPIRIT urged to secure a forward placing racing into the first turn, bid between foes for command leaving the far turn but quickly flattened out. DEB'S CONTE, forced a bit wide early, tracked the pace between foes but lacked the needed late response. SMOKE N ASPHALT was hustled to the lead along the inside from the break, went well clear on the backstretch but emptied out when completely spent racing through the far turn. SHARP ROMA settled outside a rival early, was caught four wide racing into the far turn and offered no rally. BARANIT swerved outwards at the start momentarily impeding several rivals, was collected, then urged to contend along the inside as part of the second flight but emptied nearing the far turn. GOLDFPOINT, bumped, then cut off just after the start by BARANIT, never menaced thereafter. MR. TEEGUN was never a factor.
