**Footnotes**

GENTLE MOMENT secured a position in the second flight racing along the inside, steadily moved to terms with the pacesetter on the bend while steadying slightly midway through the turn, bid inside the pacesetter to wrest command entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. DICTUM tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight in early stages, bid four wide between foes into upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner while proving best of the others. ZIZI CAT tracked just off the second flight under some reserve racing into the turn, awaited an opening entering upper stretch, then shifted out five deep in the final stages while continuing willingly to earn a share. MY MAN JAY, squeezed between foes, then steadied at the start, shifted outside foes while being urged to contention racing into the bend, advanced five wide on the turn to gain striking distance after a half but flattened out in upper stretch. CHIEF SOMERSET angled to the inside tracking off the second flight while unhurried early, advanced inside foes to briefly challenge after a half but failed to sustain his momentum. DONTA, off slowly, gathered some momentum on the turn, angled six wide racing into upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. SOUTHERN MUDD, crowded at the start, was settled along the inside racing to the turn and never gained contention. SORROWFUL JONES was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival, shifted out on the turn while gaining a brief advantage but emptied out quickly once headed by the winner. FIESTY KNIGHT angled inwards to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the bend but was spent after three furlongs. LINE CAMP broke inwards impeding a rival, tracked just off the first flight between foes three deep racing to the turn but retreated from contention early.
