Footnotes

HIGH FLYING JAKE, prompted to secure a forward placing along the inside in the opening stages, attended a rival's pace in the opening quarter, was urged to press the issue inside that foe racing into the turn, shook clear racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure despite feelings the effects of a strong crosswind. CATCH THE TRAIN was urged to gain a position just off the first flight while inside a rival in the opening stages tracking the leaders, shifted out three deep racing into upper stretch while being roused to advance but couldn't gain terms with the winner. BANJAMMER broke inwards bumping INEXCESSIVE SUE, was righted to track off the second flight along the inside racing into the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and was making mild progress along the rail to late stages while earning a share. MING GLO tracked the leaders three deep from behind the second flight racing to the turn, shifted in racing into upper stretch and continued evenly. GO POSSE GO was settled in last racing to the turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch, then split foes three deep in late stages while making an effort to improve his position. RUSSIAN STANDART tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn, then lost some position racing into upper stretch while drifting out when feeling the effects of a strong crosswind. INEXCESSIVE SUE, bumped at the start, was settled along the inside in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. COWBOY JONES, urged to the fore outside a rival in the opening stages, pressed the pace outside that foe racing into the turn, drifted out markedly leaving the quarter mile marker and gave way. BIG BULL was settled between foes off the second flight and dropped out of contention early.
