Footnotes

BOSCO RULES, urged from the outset to dispute the pace between foes racing through the backstretch, shifted to the rail nearing the turn while continuing to press the issue inside a rival, dueled into upper stretch, edged away to a clear advantage midstretch and held sway to the end under strong handling. SWEETEST RHYTHM settled off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, made steady progress three deep on the bend to challenge outside the leaders racing into upper stretch but couldn't gain terms with the winner while proving best of the others. TEXAS HEDGE was settled in the last flight along the inside in the opening half, switched outside foes on the turn, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride late to close the gap while earning a share. SUMMER'S EMPIRE settled outside a rival in the last flight in the opening stages, gained some position while angling out four wide racing through the turn, continued in that path between foes into upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages. HANDSOME BRUNO tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. TIMELESS FACTS tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing through the backstretch, continued three deep between foes racing into the turn and came up empty in upper stretch. GRAY joined the pace three deep in the opening stages, pressed the issue outside a rival racing into upper stretch and gave way. OUGHTA BE MINE tracked off the second flight along the inside under some reserve, was held up in traffic entering the turn and never gained striking distance. BUILT TO PRECISION was urged to dispute the pace inside foes soon after the break but was spent after a half.
