Footnotes

TRIPLE CHECK was settled out of striking distance in the opening stages, made steady progress outside foes on the far turn to gain terms with the leaders, shifted out five deep in upper stretch to challenge, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and drew well clear under firm encouragement. FIRE CLOUD, prominent three wide in the opening stages, was held up just off the pacesetter for a half, engaged that foe for command racing into the far turn, dueled between foes into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner but proved best of the others. CANNON'S CALL tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight in the opening half, advanced to challenge three deep racing through the far turn but had no final kick. KOKOMO GYPSY, bumped at the start, was reserved in the opening half, then split foes racing into upper stretch to make a mild bid. RULER OF THE COURT, prominent along the inside from the break, was taken back off the leaders to stalk those foes along the rail racing into the far turn, briefly awaited an opening racing through upper stretch and couldn't produce the needed final response. DURAZNO was urged to secure the lead from between foes racing into the first turn, dueled for command inside a rival to upper stretch and gave way. CHARLIE BABY was settled along the inside early and never gained striking distance. LIGHTHOUSE PRIDE broke out bumping KOKOMO GYPSY, was reserved along the inside racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. FIREMAN JERRY angled inside moving to a tracking position in the second flight racing into the first turn but steadily retreated after a half.
