PROSICO broke sharply, attended a rival's pace racing off the inside, skirmished with that foe into upper stretch, drifted out exchanging contact with OFFICER FRANK while being headed by that foe in the final sixteenth but resolutely prevailed under brisk left handed pressure. The latter was held up out of striking distance racing well off the inside in the opening stages, made a steady three wide advance to challenge the leaders nearing midstretch, drifted inwards a bit while gaining terms with the winner and exchanging repeated contact with that foe, then came up second best. STORM BOOT LARRY bobbed a bit at the start, was righted, then urged to dispute the pace along the rail, dueled grudgingly for command into upper stretch and weakened in the last furlong. PAPA settled along the inside in the opening half, angled outside a tiring foe entering upper stretch but never gained contention. BLYDE RIVER BOY angled inwards while under some reserve early to track the pace between foes, made some brief progress nearing upper stretch but came up empty racing through the lane.
