Footnotes

SIR KIPLING, reserved along the inside from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, shifted off the inside after a half while steadily gaining contention, was urged to challenge the leaders four deep approaching the quarter mile marker, gained a clear advantage in that path racing through upper stretch and maintained a clear advantage to the end under pressure. CONTEMPORARY ART, reserved between foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail racing through the backstretch, steadily drew into contention nearing upper stretch while briefly awaiting an opening, split foes just off the inside in the lane and closed the gap late while always only second best. CURZON STREET, caught four wide between foes racing into the first turn, was eased off the leaders to track outside foes to the far turn, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to earn a share. SGT. MAJOR ROSS, caught five wide racing into the first turn, continued under some prompting to race four deep just off the first flight into the far turn and failed to menace while regaining some position racing into the stretch. WICENTY joined the pace outside a rival racing to the first turn, dueled between foes into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. DOVER BEACH attended the pace three deep under rating racing to the backstretch but came up empty when called upon to advance nearing upper stretch. HIPPODROME, reserved well off the field racing to the far turn, never gained contention. TOP ROCK SOUTH was urged to dispute the pace inside foes racing to the backstretch, dueled into the far turn and gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
