**Footnotes**

GOLDEN JASON moved to fore in the opening stages while angling to the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, then edged clear racing through upper stretch under steady hand urging. SEVENOAKS angled inwards early while being rated between foes off the second flight, made steady progress splitting rivals three deep leaving the turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued willingly to edge a rival for place honors. EMPIRE TAKER angled to the inside early tracking just off the second flight, steadily gained position inside foes racing into the turn, switched out nearing upper stretch to challenge the winner but couldn't match terms with that foe while missing for second. IT'S A BAD RAPIT shifted outside the pacesetter early to track just off that rival between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but steadily faded entering upper stretch. HARLAN'S WAY broke slowly, settled near the inside and made an effort to improve position inside rivals late. RATION angled inwards to gain terms with the second flight early, prompted the pacesetter three deep racing into the bend and gave way between foes racing into upper stretch. FORTY FOUR NORTH, bumped at the start, was settled off the second flight racing to the turn and lacked a closing response. SEVENTH SON bumped soundly at the start, shifted out five deep early while being prompted to advance racing into the turn, then steadily faded in that path nearing upper stretch. LARGE SCALE, reserved while racing widest early, never gained contention.
