Footnotes

PALOOKA raced close up off the rail, rallied to the lead in the stretch and held sway in the run to the wire. DEMON STEAM raced off the rail near the middle of the field and rallied for the place while no match for the winner. SUM OF IT ALL raced inside near the middle of the field, came out four wide for the drive and loomed a threat in the stretch but lacked a winning bid. STARSHIP MAX made a bid in the stretch but flattened out. GOLDEN HERITAGE lacked speed and passed tired ones. SERIOUS TALK was always outrun. SWEET WATER RIM vied for the lead inside and tired. DEVIL SIAH contested the pace from off the rail and tired.
