THE REAL CHAS vied for the lead inside, early, drew off in the turn and held on. EXECUTIVE COACH raced in the second flight inside then rallied, taken up sharply inside then came again too late. LITTLE MAC ATTACK was unhurried early, made a bid on the turn and did not rally. FULL FLAME raced evenly, and was five wide in the stretch. BLYDE RIVER BOY showed no early speed then passed tiring rivals. CHARTER CLASS trailed early and not a factor. MILITARY LEGEND vied for the lead between horses and dropped back between horses. BIGTIME MAC was through early and outrun. CACTUS TOWN vied for lead four wide, was used up and stopped. THERE WAS A JOCKEY'S OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF LALO'S BABY BEAR BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
