Footnotes

BEARIFIC secured a forward placing while angling to the rail in the opening sixteenth, shifted outside the pacesetter when relinquishing the lead to that foe on the first turn, stalked just off the pacesetter in hand to the far turn, made steady progress on the second bend to wrest command entering upper stretch and went clear late under firm encouragement. INVISIBLE STAR angled inwards to gain a tracking position between foes in the second, shifted out leaving the far turn to challenge three deep but couldn't gain terms with the winner while proving second best. SATYRS was briskly roused to the lead while angling over racing into the first turn, dictated the pace along the rail into the far turn, couldn't match the winner entering upper stretch and weakened late. LUCKY MERLOT angled to the inside to track the leaders in second flight in the opening half, shifted off the rail entering upper stretch to challenge between foes but had no final kick. IRISH RUFFIAN, reserved saving ground in the opening half shifted out to make some mild progress in late stages. WHATITSALLABOUT tracked the leaders racing three wide as part of the second flight to the backstretch, continued in that path into the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch.
