TALES OF THE WILD broke outwards, came under immediate pressure to correct his course while gaining a forward placing, stalked just off the leaders along the inside racing into the bend, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch to challenge and wrested command in late stages under firm handling. TEST MARKET, bumped by CALDO CAT at the start, was quickly righted to press the pacesetter racing into the bend, dueled with that foe into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner but edged a rival for second in the closing stages. WILLIE PREVAIL was hustled to the lead while angling to the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command inside a rival into upper stretch and failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. COOL HEART, a bit reluctant to load, raced just off the first flight four deep in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders nearing the turn, shifted outside foes on the turn, was carried out by FIESTY KNIGHT after a half, was taken back off that foe, shifted inwards and made a second effort racing through the stretch to improve his placing. CALDO CAT broke inwards, bumped TEST MARKET, was settled into stride along the inside but never gained striking distance. IMAGE OF SUGAR, steadied out of tight quarters just after the start, lost position to his rivals and never menaced thereafter. FIESTY KNIGHT, held up just off the leaders racing five deep in the opening quarter, shifted inwards a bit on the bend while making a brief bid, then drifted out markedly after a half impeding COOL HEART while abruptly giving way.
