ROMACACA, stumbled badly, then swerved out at the start, recovered quickly pulling herself to the lead racing three deep into the first turn, moved to command while angling to the rail on the first turn, dictated the tempo under light rating to the far turn, shook clear nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady left handed prompting. A SHE'S ADORABLE, reserved outside foes in the opening stages, made steady progress on the second turn to gain terms with the second flight nearing upper stretch, angled three wide and closed the gap on the winner to the end while always second best. SECRET KIN, brushed at the start, was reserved off the leaders racing inside a rival to the backstretch, angled four wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly to earn a share. APPLE MARTINI, reserved saving ground to the backstretch, advanced in tandem with a rival while shifting off the inside leaving the far turn, split foes three wide in late stages and continued with a mild bid. AFLEET DECEIT, urged to secure a forward placing along the inside from the outset, stalked just off the pacesetter racing into the far turn but came up empty after six furlongs. CURE FOR SALE (ARG) broke inwards brushing SECRET KIN, was quickly righted to gain a forward placing between foes racing into the first turn, chased the pacesetter outside a rival into the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch.
