Footnotes

RAINBOW BLOSSOM, in touch with the leaders from the outset, was held up just off the pacesetter racing along the rail in the opening stages, continued under reserve to the second bend, came through when presented an opening to challenge inside the pacesetter nearing the furlong marker and just edged that foe in late stages under firm left handed encouragement. TRIPPING angled to the inside while readily moving to the fore racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on narrow margin under rating into the second bend, shifted out while being roused to maintain that advantage entering upper stretch, resisted the winner's bid to late stages but came up second best. HIGH ON KITTEN, reserved off the second flight outside foes in the opening half, advanced to contention four wide on the far turn, raced in that path to upper stretch and continued willingly to late stages to close the gap while prevailing for a share. ZEENUT, reserved off the second flight near the inside in the opening half, shifted out to split foes racing into upper stretch and was making mild progress to the end while being outfinished for a share. MISS ADDISON tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, advanced to lodge a brief, three wide bid midway through the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. SILVER CRUSH, reserved along the rail from behind the second flight in the opening half, never gained striking position. DELUXE HEIR was settled well off the second flight racing off the rail in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. CRISPY, on terms with the leader from the outset, was rated attending that rival's pace racing to the far turn but quickly emptied out midway through the second bend. PRINCIPALIA trailed throughout.
