GARBURETOR raced on the rail early, circled field then ran down the leaders and stayed on. TURNPIKE TOMMY stalked the pace four wide, had a brief lead in the stretch and held place. BREAKING NEWS had an inside trip, moved to the leaders in the stretch but couldn't get past. SUMMER BALLAD was inside then angled out, made a bid mid-stretch but was not good enough. ONE TRUE THING set the pace, led to top of the stretch and faltered. MR. SEABRA was void of early speed, raced five wide in the stretch. STARS OF THE SEA had speed for half and widest in the lane. RACE RUN IN LANE 3.
