ADAM N TONY, reserved in hand while being guided to the inside in the opening quarter, gradually gathered momentum after a half, swung out five wide in upper stretch and responded to firm encouragement to wrest command and pull clear late. FIGHTING FRIAR tracked the pace unhurried while four deep in second flight early, advanced in that path to challenge entering upper stretch, made steady progress to the end but was outkicked by the winner. OUTLAW ZEN angled inwards gaining a forward placing just after the start, stalked just off the pacesetter to upper stretch, moved to wrest command between calls in the last furlong but was outfinished by the top pair. WINDY CITY LEAL tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, raced in some close quarters nearing upper stretch, angled out in late stages and continued willingly to the end. MONTAGNA RIO stalked just off the the pacesetter racing three wide into the turn and steadily weakened in the drive. NITPICKER broke sharply, angled to the inside to dictate the pace racing into the bend, held sway to the furlong marker but failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. SUCHAFOOL tracked the leaders unhurried on the rail as part of the second flight racing to the bend but came up empty entering upper stretch. BOLD GENTLEMAN tracked the leaders racing three deep in second flight between foes racing into the bend and steadily faded after a half. FEAR NOR FAVOR, allowed to settle in the opening stages, shifted outside a rival while being urged to contend racing into the turn, was carried out six wide by that foe entering upper stretch and had no further response.
