Footnotes

GARLAND'S SPIRIT joined the pace outside foes from the outset dictating terms on a narrow margin, edged clear racing into upper stretch and held the advantage under pressure. GLOBAL ALLIANCE tracked the leaders along the inside from just out of striking distance for a half, steadily advanced between foes racing into upper stretch, angled to the rail in the lane and prevailed for place honors late. BLUE CANOE settled last racing to the turn, shifted out five wide nearing upper stretch and continued to make mild progress to late stages while gaining a share. U STEP ASIDE tracked off the first flight while shifting off the inside nearing the bend, switched out four wide nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance but had no final kick. DAKOTA'S COURT, in touch with the first flight between foes prompting the pace in the opening stages, steadily faded nearing upper stretch. PRICELESS SHORE, within striking distance four deep racing just off the first flight in the opening stages, moved to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. ITALIAN BREEZE was urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing into the bend and gave way abruptly entering upper stretch. THE HALF MILE SPLIT WAS HAND TIMED.
