Footnotes

AUTUMN SPLENDOR, forwardly placed prompting the pacesetter racing to the turn, continued with a steady effort to wrest command racing into upper stretch and drew away under pressure. TORBO'S BANK tracked the leaders four wide in the opening stages from just out of striking distance, was urged to advance in that path racing into upper stretch and prevailed for place honors. FEATHERINTHEBREEZE tracked off the second flight between foes racing into the turn, split foes three deep racing through the stretch and continued in an effort to improve position. SAINT PATTY ANN, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. HARD ROCK GIRL worked her way to the inside early dropping off the second flight, switched out nearing upper stretch and continued evenly between foes late. MYKUKUBIRD sped to the fore from the break while angling to the rail, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. WIN FRIENDLY tracked the pace between foes from out of striking distance behind the second flight racing to the turn but offered no closing bid. TRULY MAJESTIC tracked just off the first flight three deep in the opening stages, moved to lodge a brief bid in that path nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. ROMAN INNOCENCE shifted out well wide on the backstretch and soon dropped out.
