Footnotes

CANDY STREET tracked the leaders inside a rival in second flight racing into the bend, made a steady advance along the rail to challenge inside foes entering upper stretch, wrested the advantage in late stages and drew away under pressure. PALE HOSE broke readily, chased the pacesetter racing into the turn, moved to terms with that foe while shifting out three deep in upper stretch and was just outkicked. DELUX DEELITE tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight and continued evenly between foes in late stages to prevail for a share. CONOR JOHN tracked off the second flight racing to the turn, shifted out four wide entering the stretch and continued with an even effort. CROOKS N THIEVES tracked the pace between foes off the second flight, shifted out five deep racing into the lane but never gained contention. PUMPKIN PUSHER settled last early and never gained contention. TWO TRICK TONY was never a factor. BAJAN RHYTHM was hustled to the lead, set the pace on a narrow margin into the stretch and emptied out.
