Footnotes

UNBRIDLED VICAR was rated off the second flight racing four deep to the backstretch, continued with a steady effort in that path into the second bend, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride in the final sixteenth to narrowly prevail in time under firm handling. MURPHYS COVERT tracked off the second flight while angling to the inside racing into the backstretch, shifted out racing into upper stretch, split foes three deep in late stages to challenge for command between foes and just missed. SCORE BABY SCORE tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight to the far turn, shifted out to split foes three deep nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance, gained the advantage midstretch but couldn't quite fend off the top pair. RHODSEY angled inwards to gain terms with a rival attending that foe's pace, pressed the issue between foes racing into the far turn to upper stretch and weakened late. LEMON CUSTARD, forwardly placed three deep tracking just off the first flight racing to the far turn, was fanned four wide racing

into upper stretch and steadily weakened entering the lane. FRANK'S TIME angled to the inside tracking the leaders in second flight, saved ground throughout and continued evenly in late stages. MING GLO was settled between foes off the second flight for five furlongs, shifted out racing into upper stretch and gained some position while making no real impression. RIVER OF NO RETURN moved to the fore along the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the far turn, dueled through the second bend to upper stretch and gave way. SAAR settled into stride near the inside early and never menaced thereafter. LEOPOLIS dropped out of contention early. TEXAS HEDGE trailed throughout.
