### Footnotes

REDBONE was reserved out of close quarters near the inside in the opening stages, split foes nearing upper stretch gathering momentum, angled out five wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm left handed encouragement. STERLINGTEN was urged through close quarters in the opening stages to gain a forward placing just off the pacesetter prompting that foe racing into the turn, wrested the advantage and went clear into upper stretch, held sway past the furlong marker and just failed to sustain that momentum. C C AND MOONLIGHT, held up in tight quarters in the opening stages, made steady progress racing into the turn, shifted out to bid three deep between foes racing through the stretch and was just outkicked by the top pair while finishing on even terms with a rival for a share. HELLO CHAS was settled last racing to the turn while angling to the inside, made steady progress in the closing stages splitting foes leaving midstretch and continued willingly inside foes to the end while finishing on even terms with a rival to earn a share. MISTER PADDY tracked the leaders four deep in second flight racing to the turn, continued with a steady bid between foes in that path leaving midstretch and was just outkicked. CELLO FELLOW broke sharply, tracked the leaders outside foes while dropping off the second flight, shifted out five wide racing into the stretch and was making mild progress late. SIMPLE MAN SKYNYRD sped to the lead, dueled for command along the inside racing into the turn and emptied out abruptly in upper stretch. PERFECT BREEZE was urged through close quarters early to gain a contending position inside foes in the opening quarter, steadied in traffic leaving the half mile marker and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
