NAGYS PIGGY BANK broke inwards, was rated just out of striking distance along the inside racing as part of the second flight in the opening quarter, steadily drew on terms with the leaders while shifting off the inside nearing upper stretch, shifted out three deep making solid contact with FULLCOURTPRESSURE in upper stretch but was roused to wrest command and draw clear in the final furlong under strong handling. C. C. BANJO settled off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, angled inwards on the turn, then came through inside foes in the final furlong to narrowly prevail for second. ANY GIVEN TIME, caught in tight quarters at the start, was held up off the second flight along the inside racing to the bend, shifted out with a sharp move to race five wide entering upper stretch and continued with interest while being just outfinished for second. TOP NOTCH BUDDY secured terms with a rival on the pace soon after the break, pressed the issue into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner in the last furlong. IN ALL DIRECTIONS, reserved along the inside racing to the turn, saved ground on the bend, angled out five wide entering upper stretch but made no impression. GRUDGE MATCH broke outwards momentarily impeding ANY GIVEN TIME, was hustled to the fore along the inside, duelled for command into upper stretch and gave way. FULLCOURTPRESSURE tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, advanced to make a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch, exchanged solid contact with the eventual winner near the three sixteenths marker and quickly gave way. SNOWKIN' GUN settled off the second flight racing three and four deep to the turn but never mounted a serious challenge.
