TURFISTE was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, turned back several challengers racing into upper stretch and made the balance of the pace under strong handling. ROCKERFELLER tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight, lost some position nearing the turn while continuing along the rail, then made some late progress inside foes racing through the stretch to prevail for place honors. BILL OF BILLS, reserved off the second flight in the opening quarter, came around foes four deep on the bend, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and continued with a mild bid to gain a share. BELELIU tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, was brushed repeatedly by CITY NUMBER nearing the turn and into upper stretch but had no final kick. SON OF TIGER broke a bit awkwardly, shifted off the inside to race between foes in the last flight to the turn but never seriously menaced. CITY NUMBER, held up three deep in the second flight in early stages, made a brief bid racing into the turn while exchanging some contact with a rival but came up empty entering upper stretch. LOST CAMPER, forwardly placed between foes, was urged to prompt the pacesetter between foes after the opening quarter, dueled for command racing through the turn and gave way in upper stretch. GALLOPING GULCH was urged to prompt the pace three wide after the opening quarter, pressed the issue in that path into the turn but emptied out nearing upper stretch.
