Footnotes

HELICOPTER was settled into stride along the inside tracking just off the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued in that position into the second bend, shifted out three wide entering upper stretch while readily advancing to striking distance, then took over and drew clear under pressure. HATTAASH moved to the fore along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the rail to the second bend, resisted when challenged racing into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid but held gamely for place honors. MY SONNY BOY, pulling a bit stalking just off the pacesetter along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out leaving the far turn to press the leader racing into upper stretch but flattened out in late stages. BALLYJAMESDUFF tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid between foes midway through the far turn but lacked the needed final bid. MINT CHIP tracked the pace unhurried three deep in the opening half racing to the far turn and came up empty nearing upper stretch. HE'S BONAFIDE, in touch with the pacesetter from the outset, attended the pace racing just outside that foe for five furlongs, made a brief bid entering the far turn but quickly emptied out.
