Footnotes

VIKING, never far back, tracked just off the leaders along the inside under light rating racing into the bend, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, switched out with a sharp move entering the lane making some contact with CHEROBEN while being roused to challenge three deep between foes, wrested command late and drew clear under firm handling. HE'SARULER sped to the fore while angling to the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the bend, dueled for command along the rail into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid but held well for the place honors. REVOLT tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, was urged to challenge three deep between foes nearing upper stretch, then shifted out avoiding some traffic entering the lane to regain some position five wide in the closing stages. CHEROBEN, reserved off the second flight while shifting off the inside early, advanced on the leaders while angling out four deep nearing upper stretch, was brushed by the winner in that path entering the lane and was just outkicked for a share in the closing stages. MORENO'S MINE, in touch with a rival attending that foe's pace in the opening stages, moved to press the issue racing into the turn, dueled between foes into upper stretch and gave way in late stages. J C FIFTY, held up off the second flight near the inside in the opening quarter, angled out six wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. FIGHTING SARGE tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages but quickly came up empty racing into the turn. MADURA GOLD broke awkwardly and never mounted a serious challenge. INSIDE REVIVAL ducked in at the start losing position to the field and soon trailed.
