Footnotes

BROKEN TRUST FUND, reserved along the rail in the opening stages, switched off the inside racing into the backstretch to track the leaders between foes, shifted out on the far turn commencing a steady four wide advance, moved to challenge for command while shifting inwards entering upper stretch, made some contact with LILY THE PINK through the last furlong but edged that rival under steady handling. The latter tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in second flight under rating racing into the backstretch, made steady progress between foes to bid for command nearing upper stretch, shifted to the rail disputing the issue to late stages while being brushed late but couldn't quite fend off the winner. CAVE CREEKER tracked the leaders along the rail behind the second flight early, steadily advanced inside foes racing into the the far turn, switched out three deep in upper stretch to bid between foes and edged a rival for a share while closing the gap on the top pair. THE BEST OPTION, reserved along the inside in early stages, shifted outside foes racing through the far turn, swung six wide entering uppe3r stretch and continued willingly while just missing for a share. JAZZ BEAT sprinted to the lead while angling over racing into the first turn, was rated in hand once establishing the advantage nearing the backstretch, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. THECUSHMAKER tracked the leaders outside a rival just off the second flight early, pulled her way to terms with the leaders three deep entering the second bend, continued between foes in close quarters to upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. FINE LOOKIN LADY, held up off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, shifted out five wide on the far turn while being prompted to advance but flattened out entering upper stretch. TWIST OF SILVER tracked the pacesetter inside a rival in second flight racing into the first turn, shifted off the inside racing under rating between foes tracking the leaders into the far turn but quickly proved empty in the drive.
