Footnotes

GLOBAL ALLIANCE tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance three deep in the second flight racing through the backstretch while under light rating early, commenced a steady advance in that path on the turn, moved to challenge racing into upper stretch and went clear late under firm handling. IOLANDA'S PERFECT was settled off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride late to prevail for second. VIKING tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out while racing into in some close quarters to bid between foes nearing upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the top pair late but continued willingly to earn a share. SENATOR DAVE tracked off the second flight between foes, angled four wide while advancing to contention racing through the turn, then continued evenly between foes in that path in late stages. ACROSS TIME broke inwards bumping O'HENNESSY, was righted to dispute the pace inside foes racing into the turn, pressed the issue to upper stretch and gave way. SACRED RANGE stumbled badly at the start, angled to the inside slowly gaining contention racing into the turn, shifted out in traffic in late stages while gaining position to the end. RAPPIN ROBBY ducked in the gap just after the start, was righted to track just off the second flight along the inside, made a brief bid inside foes nearing upper stretch but flattened out late. SAY SONNY worked his way to the inside tracking off the second flight, shifted out avoiding traffic leaving the quarter mile marker but lacked the needed late response. O'HENNESSY bobbed at the start, then was bumped, was righted to tracked between foes just off the second flight racing into the turn but offered no closing bid. C. C. BANJO was settled outside foes in the last flight early, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch but made no impression. HALF FOXY briefly disputed the pace between foes in the

opening stages but emptied out early. COOL THUNDER joined the pace three deep in the opening furlong, pressed the pace racing into the turn and gave way after a half.
