FOR FILLIES, THREE YEAR OLDS. Nominations close May 25, 2012 with no fee. A Supplementary Nomination of \$500 may be made on Wednesday May 30, 2012, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$100 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$65,000 Added; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHT: 122 lbs. Non winners of \$50,000 allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 once or \$20,000 twice allowed 5 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) This event will be limited to fourteen starters (14). Highweights preferred. Preference of horses with equal weight will be Highest Total Earnings in 2012. Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Nominations Closed Friday, May 25, 2012, with 21.

ST. LOUIS CITY was urged to secure the lead along the inside from the outset, dictated the tempo on a narrow margin racing to the bend, dueled for command inside a rival on the turn, shook clear entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. IRE settled off the second while angling nearer to the inside, continued along the rail racing into the bend, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes three deep and continued with a steady effort to prove best of the others. EMONA tracked the leaders three deep between foes in second flight racing into the bend and continued willingly in that path to late stages to close the gap while earning a share. LOTTA LOVIN ducked inwards a bit at the start, was quickly righted to track just off the leaders along the rail racing into the turn, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed closing response. SABRINA'S DANCE joined the pace three deep in the opening stages, continued to press the issue outside the eventual winner racing into upper stretch but gave way when proving no match. ATLANTIC TAP vied briefly for command between foes racing through the backstretch but emptied out after a half. NIGHTOFSOLANCE tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight on the backstretch, was caught four wide racing through the turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
