### Footnotes

THUS took up a position stalking the first flight under light rating a bit off the inside in the opening half, shifted to the rail midway through the turn while steadily moving to striking position, split foes just off the inside to challenge for command racing into upper stretch, then took charge and drew clear under firm pressure. JOY FILLED settled off the leader four wide early, was guided to the rail nearing the five furlong marker commencing her advance, moved to challenge for command racing inside foes entering the turn, gained a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. MY PRINCESS DAWN, in touch with the first flight three deep early stalking those foes, moved to challenge four wide racing through the turn but flattened out nearing upper stretch. CAJUN DIVA gained terms with a rival attending that foe's pace racing a bit off the rail in the opening half, was urged to press between foes entering the bend and came up empty nearing upper stretch. MISS CLARK COUNTY joined the pace outside a rival soon after the break, pressed the issue three deep between foes racing into the bend and gave way after six furlongs.
