CAT HOP lacked speed four wide and rallied belatedly for a share. ROJO SOL lacked speed and improved her position. STARLET SKY raced three wide near the middle of the field and weakened. ONE PERFECT DAY saved ground but gave way. DAYTIME PLEASURE stalked the pace from off the rail and gave way. RACE RUN IN LANE 1, RAIL AT 0.
