SHERIFF BULLOCK, bumped at the start, was urged to secure a forward placing in the opening sixteenth, shifted in towards the rail while relinquishing the lead entering the first turn to track just off the leaders, switched out three deep on the backstretch, advanced in that path to challenge midway through the far turn, gained a narrow advantage after six furlongs, shifted nearer the inside in upper stretch and turned back several challengers racing through the stretch to prevail under strong handling. DOUG JUNIOR, unhurried between foes while racing in close quarters in the opening quarter, advanced in tandem with a rival to striking distance while caught four wide racing through the far turn but continued with a steady bid to gain place honors late. FAN TAN MAN,

held up off the eventual winner in second flight when caught in tight quarters along the rail racing into the first turn, tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance for five furlongs, shifted outside some tiring foes racing through the far turn to advance three deep between foes, shifted to the rail entering upper stretch and continued willingly inside foes to late stages to gain a share. PEYTONVILLE broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, was steadied when racing in tight quarters three deep between foes in the second flight racing into the first turn, continued outside foes to challenge four wide racing in tandem with the winner nearing upper stretch but flattened out between foes in late stages. PRINCE OF SPEED, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted off the inside to race three deep into upper stretch but made an effort to improve his position. SAHM LIKE IT HOT was urged to the fore from between foes racing to the first turn, angled in after the opening furlong to dispute the issue inside a rival racing to the backstretch, continued to contest the lead along the rail into the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. C SAGA RYDER was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. MALIBU VICE settled off the second flight between foes racing to the backstretch and never seriously menaced. MAGIC MAN, caught four wide racing between foes to the backstretch, soon dropped out of contention. IKE'S BOY broke inwards bumping MAGIC MAN, was urged to challenge the leaders racing five deep into the first turn, angled in after the opening quarter to press the issue outside a rival to the far turn but gave way after six furlongs.
