Footnotes

CITY NUMBER joined the pace outside a rival soon after the break, shook clear entering the turn, then maintained a narrow advantage while repelling two challengers racing into the stretch to prevail under hand urging and steady handling. JUMP 'IEN tracked the leaders between foes just off the second flight while unhurried, made steady progress splitting foes to challenge inside the pacesetter entering upper stretch, closed the gap midstretch but proved only second best. OLIVER tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out entering the bend commencing a steady advance, moved to challenge the leader in the three path nearing upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the top pair late. CAVE'S VALLEY settled in last in the opening stages, angled to the inside on the turn, shifted outside foes entering upper stretch and gained some position in an even effort. BELELIU was urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the outset, steadied while racing in some tight quarters leaving the seven sixteenths marker, continued to track the pacesetter along the inside racing through the turn but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. KOKA KOLA OCEAN tracked the pace outside foes as part of the second flight in the opening stages but emptied out early.
