Footnotes

LORD OF THE ROSES broke sharply, shifted to the inside disputing the pace outside a rival, gained the advance between calls racing through the backstretch, dueled for command inside a rival racing into the turn and gamely held that foe to the end under brisk handling in a prolonged drive. JOHAR IRISH was steadied a bit between foes in the opening stages while prompted to gain a forward placing, moved to terms with the pacesetter racing into the turn, pressed that foe to upper stretch, continued grudgingly in a protracted skirmish and was just outkicked. TWO LIONS, urged to secure a forward placing while shifting inwards a bit in the opening stages, tracked the leaders inside a rival in second flight racing into the turn, couldn't gain terms with the top pair racing into the stretch and finished evenly late while prevailing for a share. LICENSE TO STEAL was steadied a bit between foes in the opening stages, continued between foes in the second flight in pursuit of the leaders racing into the turn, couldn't gain terms with the top pair and was outfinished for a share. BRIMMERTON settled off the second flight near the inside early, steadied sharply while shifting outside a stricken foe racing through the backstretch, continued unhurried along the inside on the bend and never gained contention. BITTER TRUTH, a bit slow into stride, was switched out sharply avoiding a stricken foe in the opening stages and never menaced thereafter. IMA SCAT CAT, held up out of tight quarters at the start, was switched out sharply avoiding a stricken foe in the opening furlong and never menaced thereafter. MOTION POTION was steadied a bit in the opening stages, continued three deep in second flight racing through the backstretch but steadily retreated from contention on the turn. KING HARLAN was urged to dispute the pace from the outset, shifted inwards striking the rail while losing his rider and was vanned off the course.
