Footnotes

SWEETPRINCESSCHARM, in close attendance to the pace three deep in the opening stages, moved to press the issue in that path on the turn to upper stretch and edged clear late under firm handling. SHARP TRIP tracked off the second flight between foes unhurried in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to gain place honors. CAMP FAIRFAX R N broke inwards crossing the path of PRETTY PERCEPTIVE, was righted to track inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch while being urged to challenge but lacked the needed final kick. BLOND WARRIOR tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight racing into the turn, angled four wide entering upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages. PROPHET'S SONG broke readily, attended the pace between foes under light reserve in the opening stages, dueled for command between foes on the bend, continued along the inside into upper stretch and gave way. FLEET ENCOUNTER broke outwards, was righted to track off the second flight along the inside racing into the turn, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch and lacked a closing bid.

JUST LOLA settled between foes in the last flight early, angled to the inside on the turn but never seriously menaced. CIRCULAR STREET, a bit slow into stride, raced outside foes in the last flight, was fanned eight wide racing into upper stretch and proved no menace. PRETTY PERCEPTIVE, shuffled back out of tight quarters at the start, raced in the last flight to the turn, angled seven wide racing into upper and proved no factor. MARKREE BREEZE was urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the outset but gave way abruptly after a half.
