ROAD WIGGLE raced close up off the rail, rallied to the front turning for home and drew off in the run to the wire. DIXIE BAY raced close up inside and rallied for the place while no threat to the top one. ROSE RANSOM was bumped from both sides at the start, raced just outside, came four wide into the stretch and gained a share in the late going. INSTINCT lacked speed, angled out for the drive and gained belatedly. MALIBU LADY pressed the pace just outside and weakened. MINT JULIE saved ground but was not a factor. SEMIPHORE never reached contention. RED HOT COOL was always outrun. SARMARZO PRINCESS was never close. LARK'S SONG set the pace from the inside while pressed and tired.
