HUMOROUS MISS lacked speed off the rail, moved up on the final turn and rallied through the stretch to win going away. INIS raced near the middle of the field, angled out and took the lead in the stretch but could not hold off the winner. ECHO SPRING raced close up, dropped back a bit and rallied belatedly for a share. GRACILE stalked the pace just outside and weakened. BAYANI raced outside and lacked a rally. QUILL PLAY improved her position in the drive. MISS SWEET TIME was never a factor. YARICO'S POND (IRE) set the pace from the inside and tired. ABSOLUTE JO lacked speed and showed little. ARDENNES was always outrun. BIRTHDAY SONG gave way after a half. FIERCE PRINCESS was rank at the start and pulled up in the stretch. (Race run in lane 5, rail out 25 feet.)
